SmartR, a wizard-based reporting tool allows you to quickly produce accurate reports on objects within your directory or GAL. Administrators can download the free version of the tool, install, run and print a meaningful report in the time it takes to read this data sheet.

Find out what's in your directory fast using Imanami SmartR. Reports have never been easier to produce than with SmartR, which allows you to view or print accurate reports on objects within your directory or Global Address List (GAL). Out-of-the-box SmartR contains canned reports that administrators cannot live without, such as "Number of members of groups," "Groups and their Owners," "Last Modified," "Users," etc.

Once you complete the wizard, SmartR gathers the information from the Microsoft Exchange server or Active Directory domain controller and writes the results to an XML file. SmartR then automatically transforms the XML results into the format you requested using an XSL stylesheet. SmartR reports are defined in an XML format, which enables you to customize or even create any report you need using your favorite text editor.
